Deadeye by Provenance Vineyards lives at the creative intersection of careful vineyard selection and winemaker's gut instinct in blending.

WINE PROFILE

This fruit-forward blend showcases dark berries, cherries, baking chocolate and baking spices. Medium tannins wash over the palate with plum and red cherry, along with a lift of blackberry and earthiness.

VINEYARD SELECTION

Select lots from outstanding Napa Valley vineyards were chosen from growing regions, including Calistoga, Oakville, Oak Knoll District and Rutherford.

VINTAGE

The 2019 growing season brought late spring rains during flowering causing fruiting to be lighter than usual. This resulted in exceptional concentration and retention of flavor and aromas. Mild fall temperatures helped the fruit to naturally mature fully, leaving us with a harvest that had mild and regulated tannins and an ideal sugar content. 2019 became an excellent vintage that will continue to impress as this wine ages in bottle.

NATURAL WINEMAKING

- Night harvest to keep the fruit cool and preserve the natural acid
- Berry sorting for the perfect berry
- 3-5 day cold soak at 50 degrees Fahrenheit for color
- Two-week primary fermentation, 85 degrees Fahrenheit stainless steel fermentations for structure Malolactic fermentation in barrels for mid-palate integration
- 18 months of barrel aging, including monthly topping and quarterly aerative rackings
- Winemaker barrel selection at blending, not all barrels made the cut
